



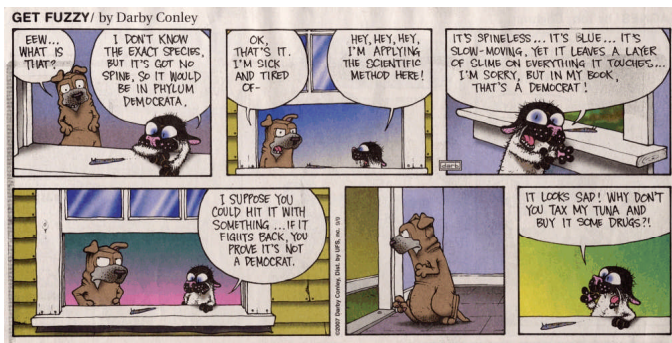

"Folks, no one is arguing that the climate has migrated to a warmer pattern over the last few decades. It's this premise that WE are causing it by driving our SUVs around that is crazy." (ET #21, Nov. 2007). According to Al Gore, our activity is adding more CO2 to the atmosphere than it can handle and thus we are seeing global warming as a result. His numbers are sketchy at best and many top atmospheric scientists are skeptical about the "fuzzy science" employed by the former Vice President. To understand the basic skepticism requires a history lesson. We will go all the way back 65 million years ago. teresting article by Lawrence Hecht. Most climatologists agree that historically with in the larger 10-12 thousand year cycles are smaller cycles that include "little ice ages". The last of these was 1400-1850. This is well documented in history. Go to this link and read the article on the lost civilization at Greenland. This article does not discuss global warming or cooling but rather the story of Greenland and what "chased off" it's Norse Inhabitants over 600 years ago. It was in fact the "little ice age" that caused conditions in Greenland to become too harsh for the Nordic people and the semi-native Inuit were the only ones to survive. The ice came down and covered Greenland in just a few hundred years. Then in 1850 we began to cycle out of the "little ice age". This was well before the industrial revolution and the age of mankind's terrible pollution.

The point of all this "history" is to illustrate the fact that these kinds of temperature changes are normal cycles that our planet goes through. Throughout these cycles animals and plants have come and gone. Nearly all of the prehistoric dinosaurs are gone. We have just Alligators and Crocodiles to remind us of their former presence at the top of the Earth's food chain. The Polar Bears will likely survive this latest round of ice retreat as they have through the many former cycles. Scientist have long contended that the great canyons and cliffs and such were in fact carved out by glacial ice advancing and retreating over and over through these varying periods in time.

While I am on a historical lesson I will address the issue you suggest that "your generation is in trouble because the past few generations have been to ignorant to notice the changes".
